The EPA's designation of Dicamba formulations used over the top of DT Soybeans/Cotton as Restricted Use Pesticides has added the requirement that all persons who will be applying a Dicamba formulation attend an Auxin Herbicide Certification Training meeting. Ohio has put the responsibility of training applicators on the Registrants, i.e. BASF, Monsanto, and DuPont. If you intend to apply Engenia, FeXapan or XtendiMax, you must attend one of the training sessions and provide a copy of your certificate to your local retailer.

These training meetings are NOT a commercial for the manufacturer providing the training. The slide decks have been approved by the Ohio Department of Agriculture.

You need to only attend one of the two-hour training sessions to complete the training. You must be present for the entirety of the meeting.
